“**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to (i) the provisions of Sections 23(1)(b), 42 and 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014 and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory amendment(s) or modification(s) thereto or enactment(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) (the “**Act**”); (ii) the provisions of Regulation 164A and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended from time to time (“**SEBI ICDR Regulations**”); (iii) any other rules / regulations / guidelines, if any, prescribed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (“**SEBI**”), Reserve Bank of India (“**RBI**”), stock exchanges where the shares of the Company are listed (“**Stock Exchanges**”) and/or any other statutory / regulatory authority; (iv) the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended from time to time (“**Listing Regulations**”); (v) the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company; and subject to the approval(s), consent(s), permission(s) and/or sanction(s), if any, of the appropriate authorities, institutions or bodies as may be required, and subject to such conditions and modifications, as may be prescribed by any of them while granting any such approval(s), consent(s), permission(s), and/or sanction(s), and which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the “**Board**” which term shall be deemed to include any Committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitute to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution), and subject to (A) the completion of the conditions precedent under the securities subscription agreement dated 7 August 2020 (as may be amended from time to time) executed between the Company and the Subscriber (defined below) (hereinafter referred to as the “**SSA**”) which *inter alia* include the Subscriber having received the approval from the Competition Commission of India for its investment into the Company, and (B) the completion of the preferential allotment of 642,523,365 equity shares and 175,233,645 warrants to the Subscriber as contemplated under the SSA subject to the approval by the Members of the Company at the extra-ordinary general meeting to be held on 2 September 2020, the consent of the Members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to further create, offer, issue and allot on preferential basis, up to 68,728,522 equity shares (“**Equity Shares**”) of the Company of face value of ₹ 2 (Rupees two) each at a price of ₹ 14.55/- (including premium) (Indian Rupees Fourteen decimal five five only) per Equity Share aggregating up to ₹ 999,999,995.10 (Indian Rupees Ninety Nine Crores Ninety Nine Lakhs Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Five decimal Ten Only), to Tube Investments of India Limited (“**Subscriber**”), an entity which does not belong to the Promoter Group, in accordance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations and other applicable laws; and on such terms and conditions as mentioned hereunder.

**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** in terms of the provisions of SEBI ICDR Regulations, the “**Relevant Date**” for the purpose of determination of minimum price for the issue and allotment of Equity Shares as mentioned above shall be 25 August 2020, being the date 30 (thirty) days prior to the date of this Extra-Ordinary General Meeting.

**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the special resolution shall be deemed to be passed only if the votes cast by the shareholders in the ‘public’ category in favour of the aforesaid proposal are more than the number of votes cast against it.

**(a) Convening of Extra-ordinary General Meeting through Video Conferencing / other Audio Visual Means facility:**

In view of the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, social distancing norm to be followed and the continuing restriction on movement of persons at several places in the country and pursuant to General Circular Nos. 14/2020, 17/2020 and 22/2020 dated 8 April 2020, 13 April 2020 and 15 June 2020 respectively, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (hereinafter collectively referred as "**MCA Circulars**") and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated 12 May 2020 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India ("**SEBI Circular**") and in compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("**Act**") and the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("**Listing Regulations**"), the Extra-ordinary General Meeting ("**e-EGM**" or "**EGM**" or "**Meeting**") of the Company is being conducted through Video Conferencing ("**VC**") / other Audio Visual Means ("**OAVM**") facility, which does not require physical presence of members at a common venue. **(b) Quorum:**

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

The following explanatory statement sets out all material facts relating to the special business mentioned in the accompanying Notice dated 2 September 2020 and shall be taken as forming part of the Notice.

### Further Issue of Equity Shares on a Preferential Allotment / Private Placement Basis to Tube Investments of India Limited:

#### Item 1

As you are aware, the Company is undergoing financial stress and is in immediate need of funds to continue its operations as a going concern. As a part of the resolution of the stress of the Company and for meeting funding requirements of its business activities and general corporate and other purposes, the Board of Directors of the Company (“**Board**”), have been in discussion with the lenders for fund raising and for resolution of debts of the Company. Following the above, the Company had received an offer dated 7 August 2020 (as modified on 11 August 2020) from **Tube Investments of India Limited** (“**Subscriber**”) for resolving the debts of the Company and to infuse capital in the Company by subscribing to equity shares worth ₹ 550 crores (approximately) and warrants worth ₹ 150 crores (approximately) on a preferential basis, to meet its business requirement (“**Original Offer**”). The Company, after obtaining the Board’s approval, had executed a Securities Subscription Agreement dated 7 August 2020 (“**SSA**”) with the Subscriber and convened an extra-ordinary general meeting on 2 September 2020 for seeking approval of the members of the Company for offer, issuance and allotment of equity shares and warrants pursuant to the Original Offer. Further, the lenders of the Company on 28 August 2020 communicated to Subscriber by their Letter of Intent that, upon conclusion of the Swiss Challenge bid process launched under the auspices of the Reserve Bank of India (Prudential Framework for Resolution of Stressed Assets) Directions 2019, they have declared Subscriber’s offer as the successful offer and Subscriber as the successful bidder, subject to compliances with all the conditions stated in the said Letter of Intent, to the satisfaction of the lenders.

Subsequent to the date of the SSA and further assessment of financial liabilities and outlook of the Company by the Subscriber, the Company received a letter from Tube Investments of India Limited to infuse additional capital in the Company aggregating up to ₹ 100 Crore (Rupees One Hundred Crore Only) (approximately) by way of subscribing to additional equity shares of the Company on a preferential allotment basis (“**Additional Offer**”) to meet the funding requirements of the Company subject to necessary corporate authorizations obtained by the Company. The Board, after considering the merits of such offer and considering that it would be in the best interest of the Company, approved an amendment to the SSA to such effect. As per the amended terms of the SSA, the offer, issuance and allotment of equity shares pursuant to the Additional Offer will be subject to (A) the completion of the conditions precedent under the SSA (as may be amended from time to time) executed between the Company and the Subscriber, which *inter alia* include the Subscriber having received the approval from the Competition Commission of India for its investment (under the Original Offer and Additional Offer) into the Company, and (B) the completion of the preferential allotment of 642,523,365 equity shares and 175,233,645 warrants to the Subscriber as contemplated under the SSA subject to the approval by the Members of the Company at the extra-ordinary general meeting to be held on September 2, 2020 .

If the conditions precedent set out in the SSA are not fulfilled, the issue and allotment pursuant to the Additional Offer shall not take place.

#### **C. The Instructions for Members for e-voting on the day of the EGM are as under:-**

1. The procedure for e-Voting on the day of the EGM is same as the instructions mentioned above for remote e-voting.
2. Only those Members/ shareholders, who will be present in the EGM through VC/OAVM facility and have not casted their vote on the Resolutions through remote e-Voting and are otherwise not barred from doing so, shall be eligible to vote through e-Voting system in the EGM.
3. Members who have voted through Remote e-Voting will be eligible to attend the EGM. However, they will not be eligible to vote at the EGM.
4. The details of the person who may be contacted for any grievances connected with the facility for e-Voting on the day of the EGM shall be the same person mentioned for remote e-voting.
5. If any votes are cast by the Members through the e-voting available during the EGM and if the same Members have not participated in the Meeting through VC/OAVM facility, then the votes cast by such Members shall be considered invalid as the facility of e-voting during the Meeting is available only to the Members attending the Meeting.
